From 14 August (1986) gummed labels in the above design, ranging in value from 1c to 99r.99, were available from an experimental machine at Sunnyside Post Office in Pretoria. The machine was moved to the "Johannesburg 100" exhibition from 6 to 11 October 1986 and was then reinstalled at Sunnyside on 17 October 1986. Further machines were introduced subsequently and each can be identified by a code number, between P001 and P034, at right. Commemorative labels were subsequently available at "PAARL 300" (1987), "PIETERMARITZBURG 150" (1988), "WANDERERS 101" (1989), "STAMPS 150" (1990), "CAPE TOWN 1991", "PRETORIA 92", "ETHEKWINI (Durban 1993) and "BENONI '94" stamp exhibitions.

A new series of machine labels, with nine different designs showing province landscapes, was introduced on 20 October 1998 with operational values from 1r.10 upwards. Sets showing other face values from 10c. to 20r. were available against special order.
