FULL STOP AFTER LEFT POSTAGE
LEFT HAND SIDE SECOND FROM TOP BLUE MARK UNDER KINGS EAR
ON THE SAME STAMP QUEENS MOUSTACHE EFFECT
LEFT HAND SIDE FOURTH STAMP DOWN GASH IN QUEENS FACE
LEFT HAND SIDE BOTTOM STAMP BLUE SPOT BETWEEN KINGS EAR AND EYETOP
RIGHT HAND TOP STAMP BEAUTY SPOT ON QUEENS CHEEK
BOTTOM RIGHT HAND STAMP BLUE SPOT ON QUEENS NECK BELOW CHAIN
PERF SHIFT UP
STAMP NO 165

VARIETIES

- Va. Full stop after left "Postage." Row 1/1
- Vb. Blue mark under King's ear. Row 2/1
- Vc. Blue stroke through "ui" of the word "Silverbruilof." Row 8/3
- Vd. Blue spot in lower corner of right hand frame lines. Row 9/1
- Ve. Retouch at centre of right side frame lines. Row 14/5
- Vf. White arc between Their Majesties Heads. Row 15/3
- Vg. Blue flaw at centre of right hand side frame lines. Row 15/4
- Vh. Broken hyphen (two dots). Row 16/5
- Vi. Blue flaw at Queen's mouth (moustache effect). Row 17/1
