CYLINDER No. 6912.
- 2d. Va. "V" mark between King and Queen. Row 5/1
- Vb. Rectangular shaped mark at left hand side of the name scroll. Row 7/3
- Vc. "Bird" shaped mark on top of numeral "2" and curved lines through side of Queen's head. Row 10/6
- Vd. Curved line running vertically from Queen's right shoulder to top frame line of the stamp above. Row 11/6
