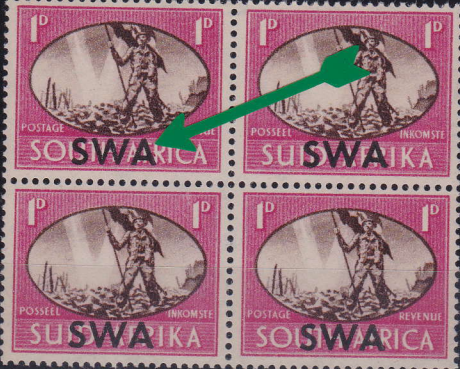


**“ VARIETY “

Varieties

- V1. Red spot on “R” of AFRICA. Row 1/5
- V2. White accent mark over “G” of POSTAGE. Row 5/1
- V3. White spot over second “S” of POSSEEL. Row 5/6
- V4. Red mark through “R” of AFRICA. Row 8/4
- V5. Additional “Barbed Wire” in base of “V”. Row 9/6

Varieties

- V1. Tiny projection on top of mountain. Row 1/2
- V2. White mark over “P” of POSSEEL. Row 6/1
- V3. White spot near edge of mountain. Row 7/3
- V4. White “Ear” on “S” of SUID. Row 11/4
- V5. White mark over “S” of SUID. Row 13/2
- V6. Two faint almost vertical violet lines forming a “V” through stamp. Row 17/5.

Varieties

- V1. White accent mark over “P” of POSSEEL. Row 2/1
- V2. White spot “Extra star” above man’s nose. Row 3/3
- V3. Blue spot above man’s eye. Row 12/3
- V4. White dot “Distant star” in sky. Row 14/1
- V5. White “Hyphen” between “3” and “D” at left. Row 14/6
- V6. Blue “Scar” on woman’s forehead Row 18/1
